## **AIM:** Recognizing the importance of true repentance

**<u>Do Now:</u>** Brainstorm Time- Connect three words that explain the attribute of repentance.

## **Opening/Introduction:** Oxford definitions of repent...

- Repent- feel or express sincere regret or remorse about one's wrong doing or sin: He repented of his action.; [with object] view or think of [an action or omission] with deep regret or remorse: Miriam came to repent her hasty judgement.; repent oneself feel regret or penitence about: I repent me of all I did.
- Repentance- the action of repenting; sincere regret or remorse (esp. Each person who turns to GOD in genuine repentance and faith will be saved)
- Repentant- expressing or feeling sincere regret and remorse, remorseful (esp. He is truly repentant for in his incredible naivety and stupidity)

-Penitence the action of feeling or showing sorrow and regret for having done wrong: a public display of penitence.

-Regret to feel sad and disappointed over something that one or someone has done or failed to do (I immediately regretted my words.), to express apology for sadness over something undesirable (We regret that no tickets may be exchanged) or at an occurrence / inability to accept an invitation (Please give your family send my regrets.)

1) **Proverbs 28:13** Whoever that covereth/conceals their faults/sins will never succeed/prosper, but whosoever confesses and gives them up will have mercy.

# **Question:** What is the key to successfully repenting of a sin?

- ✓ The key to successful repentance of a sin (addictions, attitudes, behaviors, habits, mindsets, etc.) is to give it up. Whatever it is you put on a high pedestal and made into a "god" needs to be brought down. Yes confession is the first part of repenting yet there is more to the process.
- **2) Ezra 10:11** Now, therefore make confession unto the The Creator Almighty / Ehyeh Asher Ehyeh / Hayah Ahsur Hayah / YHWH Yahuwah GOD of your fathers, and do his pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives.

## Question: Can a person confess a sin and make an oath to never do it again?

- ✓ Yes a person can. Yet it is wise one never make an oath to THMYHWH if they are still too immature to accept it has to go and are completely unready to remove it from your life. Anyone can speak or know they have committed a sin but it takes a mature individual to separate themselves and delete it from their life than add the word of YAH.
- ✓ It would be best to fast and pray for The Most High Yah to strengthen you to get over the desires of such sin before making a promise you will be held accountable to keep.

**3) John 8:11** She said, No man, Lord. And Yeshua / Yahshayah / Yahushuwah / Emmanuel said to her, Neither do I condemn thee: **GO, AND SIN NO MORE.** 

Question: Why is sinning no more the only way to mercy and true salvation?

- ✓ Sinning no more (in that specific sin / confession) is the true method of receiving salvation from THE MOST HIGH YAH. Separating yourself from the things of your past is a necessary requirement. Completely letting the object, action, person, or place go is the next step and most important part!
- ✓ It's only easy to do this when you realize the best is yet to come and never behind in the past!
- ✓ When you can totally walk away from your past flesh behaviors then you have finally embarked on self-control and full maturity of salvation through the redemption of this flesh (your borrowed vessel). Self-discipline is the only way for full recovery from sins.
- **4) 2 Timothy 1:7** For YAH has never given us a spirit of fear (cowardice); but of power, and of love, and of a sound-mind (self-control, self-discipline, to control ourselves).
- 5) Ezekiel 18:21-23 Moreover, if the wicked one repents of all the sins that thee committed and keep all My laws and do that which is just and right, thee shall surely live, and neither die. None of the transgressions they've committed shall be remembered against thee; because of the righteousness thee has practiced, thee shall live. Is it my desire that a wicked person shall die?... says the Sovereign GOD. It is rather that thee shall turn back from their ways and live.
- 6) Acts 3:18 But those things, which YAH before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Hamaishach should suffer, he hath so fulfilled. 19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord of Spirits. 20 And he shall send Yeshua / Yahshayah / Yahushuwah / Emmanuel which before was preached unto you. 21 Whom the heavens must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which YAH hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

**Question:** How does sinning no more stop the temptations or offensives from coming?

- ✓ What we all need to be aware of is that the temptations will get stronger with each confession. That is the job of the demons/shades of this world they have to see who they can devour.
- ✓ Offensives will come to prove you are a keeper of your words.
- ✓ Everyday will be a test but with each passing you will get stronger spiritually to defend yourself physically and stronger physically to defend yourself spiritually. Yet with each failure you will get weaker spiritually and more defenseless physically vice versa.

**Question:** What happens to a person who goes back to sinning a past sin?

✓ Try walking backwards in your everyday life and you will realize it's just an injury waiting to happen. This is what happens to ppl who go back to sinning a past sin.

- ✓ Only the ones who can rebuke their own flesh will survive and pass the test. Verbally "life and death is in the power of the tongue" you have to call death upon the desires of your flesh. Spiritually your word and actions can destroy in the spirit realm. If you complain too much speak, to cut your tongue out your mouth, if you masturbate.
